

**CLARK COUNTY R-1

Dr. Kracht presented the following Administrative plan of action to the Clark County School Board.:

1. Close school through Friday, April 3, with students scheduled to return on Monday, April 6. We will reevaluate opening school as we approach the April 3rd Date.
2. All school sponsored functions are canceled/postponed
3. All district facilities will be closed to non-essential personnel. No outside groups will be allowed to use district facilities during the closure. Teachers will be given access to buildings to finish up necessary tasks.
4. Administrative team will work with Clark County emergency management and OPAA! To develop a meal delivery plan for students. We may ask for volunteers from the staff to help with meal distribution.
5. Principals will create a list of optional enrichment activities for students and will post the lists on Facebook and the District's webpage.
6. Mr. Harper will make contact with high school students concerning college credit courses.
7. Pay all staff during the shutdown.
