The health department is offering the option to reduce quarantine lengths effective January 14, 2021. The school agreed that with the current positivity rate the reduction in quarantine time would be acceptable for school related quarantines.

Mr. Harper and Mr. Church talked about how students are struggling academically in orange status. Switching to the mask mandate was discussed. The Board wants to continue in orange

status for now to find out if the holiday gatherings will cause a spike in the county positive cases. The board will reevaluate the situation in two weeks.

Mr. Harper is also going to discuss with junior parents about changing the date of prom to May 29th. He will bring the information for discussion to the February board meeting.
